



Environmental Policy

The Colour Assembly Ltd recognises the importance of environmental protection and is committed to operating its business responsibly in compliance with all environmental regulations, legislation and approved codes of practice relating to both its industry and its activities. It is the Company's objective to operate with and to maintain good relations with all regulatory bodies.

It is the Company's declared policy to carry out all measures reasonably practical to meet, exceed or develop all necessary or desirable requirements and to continually improve environmental performance.

With the continual advances in technology within the printing industry, our requirement for chemicals and solvents is greatly reduced. However, The Colour Assembly Ltd has adopted the following specific procedures to minimise the effects of our activities on the environment:

Assessment	Assess and regularly re-assess the environmental effects of the Company's activities and implement changes as and when necessary.
Suppliers	All contractors and suppliers to our business are checked for approval to our environmental policy and are correctly licensed for all environmental requirements within their respective services.
Training	Ongoing training of all employees in environmental issues and subsequent changes in legislation.
Advice	We provide free and impartial advice and encouragement to all customers on the levels of environmental impact of the various paper types, particularly the terminology behind chlorine free and recycled papers.
Waste Metal & Film	Aluminium printing plates and used films are collected for recycling by J&G Metals - a licensed company*.
House Keeping	All staff are constantly encouraged to conserve energy by turning off equipment/machines, taps and lights when not in use. All computer systems and work stations have energy save modes which are automatically activated after a set period of inactivity. All company vehicles use green fuel by order.

This policy is communicated to all employees, suppliers and is made available to the public.
